We are to search and study. God will provide the answers and guidance. The last part of the chapter reveals some of the benefits. Other passages offer even more benefits such as 2 Timothy 3:16–17, John 1, and Psalm 119, not to mention every page of Scripture. Depend on the guidance, conviction, and comfort of the Holy Spirit regularly, and take things one day at a time.

Discouraged parents can find new hope and direction. Sadly today, many instructional materials can leave us wondering just what we should be presenting. God's Word is the truth.
