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About This Book

This song book provides parents and teachers ways of using music to correlate with the Bible passages they are covering with their children and students.

The first section has are songs with familiar tunes for younger children.

The second section lists hymns suitable for children of all ages when carefully taught and explained where necessary. The hymns have been selected for their content, their infrequent use of challenging concepts and wording, and their moderate musical ranges. They are listed alphabetically, topically and scripturally. They are available in most standard hymnals. This is not an exhaustive list.

When selecting a new hymn, look for its relationship to the current passage of study. Read the first stanza aloud and explain a challenging word or concept. Sing the first stanza, and then have the children sing it with you. Limit the length of the sections at first, and repeat it a few times.

Review familiar hymns along with adding add new hymns. Continue learning additonal verses of each hymns. Relate them to Bible passages where appropriate. There are wonderful books available giving the history of some of the hymns and their writers to use from time to time.

Colossians 3:16-17 tells us that we are to admonish one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Music is a wonderful ministry God has given us to use with grace in our hearts.
